




THE CALL:

We are calling on the women of the church to join us in striking from sexism by withholding time, labor, and financial resources from the church during Lent 2025.




THE GOAL


Our goal is straightforward: To remove all barriers to ministry and governance—including Holy Orders—for women and people of all genders.



WHY NOW?

- We are not being heard, or worse, we have been heard and church leaders fail to act.
- The Synod on Synodality ended with no measurable or meaningful progress toward opening more ministries to women.
- We reject the Vatican's tactical timetable of endless "study" and need for "maturation"
- Women's labor, ministry, and resources are exploited, undervalued, or invisible in church structures, parishes, and at the Vatican.





WHAT DOES IT MEAN TO STRIKE?


Withholding time, labor, and resources from the church will look different for different people—and for some of you, perhaps it's something you've been doing for a long time already. Here are some examples:


- If you attend a parish regularly, choose not to attend for the duration of Lent 2025 and instead find a woman-led community online where you can be spiritually nourished.
- If you volunteer for a parish or Catholic institution, decline to take on your usual tasks during Lent 2025: anything from lectoring to religious education. You may wish to inform your parish leadership ahead of time.
- If you work for a parish or Catholic institution, plan to walk out on a specific day or more with your colleagues. For example March 10th, following the first Sunday in Lent. Please reach out to us about any concerns about job risks if you strike during Lent. Our aim is to offer financial and moral support to make this feasible.
- If you already essentially "strike" from the church—withholding your labor, your presence, and your financial resources—we want to know!

The mountains are coming alive, the fire-kindled mountains, moving again to reshape the earth.


It is we sleeping women, waking up in a darkened world, cutting the chains from off our bodies with our teeth, stretching our lives over the slow earth—
